Bird Watching: The old saying is true, so early start! Burrillville is a paradise for the birder, with thousands of acres pristine environments in a handful of protected management areas. Access is relatively easy to every imaginable terrain and habitat: uplands, lowlands, rivers, ponds and streams, evergreen and deciduous forests, scrub and brush.

Start your morning with a hike through the **Black Hut Management Area** in search of your fondest feathered friend.

You'll have an appetite after trekking through the woods, so stop in at **Western Hotel Pizza & Tavern**, one of a number of restaurants that populate our local villages.

Once you are refueled, drop your **kayak** into the **Branch River** or **Clear River** to catalog the aquatic birds that make their nests along the riverbanks of Burrillville and view the serene woodland landscape from a different vantage point.
