

# *Fishing the Mill Towns*

With a fishing area in nearly all of its eight villages, Burrillville is prime fishing country. The town has the largest quantity of stocked fishing areas in Northern Rhode Island and holds a couple of the sport fish records for freshwater species in the state. Lakes, ponds, brooks, and rivers provide a selection of species for you to catch and are supplied with trout each spring.

Quality boat fishing is available at **Harrisville Fishing Area, Spring Lake, and Union Pond**, while bank or canoe fishing is spectacular at **Round Top Management Area and Tarklin Pond**.

If a different style of fishing interests you, visit **Addieville East Farm** in Mapleville where they will provide fly fishing instruction, a bass lake, and private trout ponds and streams. Be sure to call for an appointment at (401) 949-2266.



Don't forget to grab your food rations at one of the many restaurants located near your preferred fishing destination and stock up on fishing supplies at **Bobby's Bait & Tackle Box**.
