

## Mountain Bikes and Waterways



If you like the challenge of **mountain biking**, try combining it with an afternoon of **kayaking** for a day of outdoor thrills.

Your off-road adventure begins at the northwestern-most corner of the state with a stretch of Rhode Island's **North/South Trail**. This wilderness trail takes you through the challenges of the **Buck Hill Management Area**.

A well-earned lunch in Pascoag provides a relaxing break and prepares you for the second half of your adventure.

**Kayaking the Clear River**, a river that is rated as 'moderate,' will take you past two waterfall portage points and leads you down to the Slatersville Reservoir. Kayaks can be rented from Blackstone Valley Outfitters in Lincoln, RI.
