

A Saturday in Harrisville

Enjoy a quaint and relaxing Saturday in the small village of Harrisville. Start of the day with a delicious breakfast at **The Waterfall Café and Bakery**. One of their many specialties is Cap'n Crunch French Toast.

Then walk over to the nearby **Stillwater Complex**. You can check out the **Burrillville Farmer's Market** and see the goods provided by local farms and vendors. Next door is **Re:discover**, an art gallery and antique store that focuses on reusing old materials to make something new. Don't forget to visit the **Jesse Smith Memorial Library**, which houses thousands of books and several special collections, including an extensive **Star Trek Collection**. Their children's library is fully furnished and has tons of books and puzzles. If you are feeling creative, head over to **Creative Ceramics** and take a ceramics painting class.



Across the street is **Freedom Park**, and the beautiful **Harrisville Waterfall**. Enjoy the beautiful scenery while the kids play on the playground, or fish in **Mill Pond** at the top of the waterfall. Across the pond is the gravesite of Austin T. Levy, Burrillville's biggest benefactor, as well as historic town buildings, and a good ole **Lil' General Store**.



If you are interested in taking a stroll, the **Harrisville-Pascoag Pedestrian Path** is close by. The path can be accessed from Mowry Street and is about a mile long. View the local beauty, and if you are feeling adventurous, take the hike to the **Duck Pond Area**. Also, several **Geocaches** can be found along the way.
