**Pascoag Reservoir** and **Spring Lake** are popular destinations for **ice fishing** and the annual **Crystal Lake Ice Fishing Tournament** has heated competition year after year.

The town of Burrillville provides thousands of acres of woodlands and open spaces to explore. The North/South Trail that traverses the **Buck Hill Management Area** provides **snowshoeing** and **cross country skiing** trails. Plus, there are ten more miles of groomed trails in the **George Washington Management Area**.

**Ice Skating** is available at **Levy Rink** in Harrisville and at local ponds & lakes when it is posted as safe. Levy Rink is open for public skating on Sundays from 11:30 a.m. until 12:50 p.m.
